

## 1 Corinthians 5:1-2 <sup>ESV</sup>

It is actually reported that there is sexual immorality among you, and of a kind that is not tolerated even among pagans, for a man has his father's wife. <sup>2</sup> And you are arrogant! Ought you not rather to mourn? Let him who has done this be removed from among you.



### 1 Corinthians 5:3-5<sup>ESV</sup>


For though absent in body, I am present in spirit; and as if present, I have already pronounced judgment on the one who did such a thing. <sup>4</sup> When you are assembled in the name of the Lord Jesus and my spirit is present, with the power of our Lord Jesus, <sup>5</sup> you are to deliver this man to Satan for the destruction of the flesh, so that his spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord.






# DISCIPLINE

Romans 6:21, 23 <sup>ESV</sup>

But what fruit were you getting at that time from the things of which you are now ashamed? **For the end of those things is death...** <sup>23</sup> **For the wages of sin is death,** but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

James 1:15b <sup>ESV</sup>

...and sin when it is fully grown **brings forth death.**

## 2 Corinthians 2:5-8 <sup>ESV</sup>

Now if anyone has caused pain, he has caused it not to me, but in some measure—not to put it too severely—to all of you. <sup>6</sup> For such a one, this punishment by the majority is enough, <sup>7</sup> so you should rather turn to forgive and comfort him, or he may be overwhelmed by excessive sorrow. <sup>8</sup> So I beg you to reaffirm your love for him.

## Matthew 18:15-17 <sup>ESV</sup>

“If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault, between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have gained your brother. <sup>16</sup> But if he does not listen, take one or two others along with you, that every charge may be established by the evidence of two or three witnesses. <sup>17</sup> If he refuses to listen to them, tell it to the church. And if he refuses to listen even to the church, let him be to you as a Gentile and a tax collector.”
