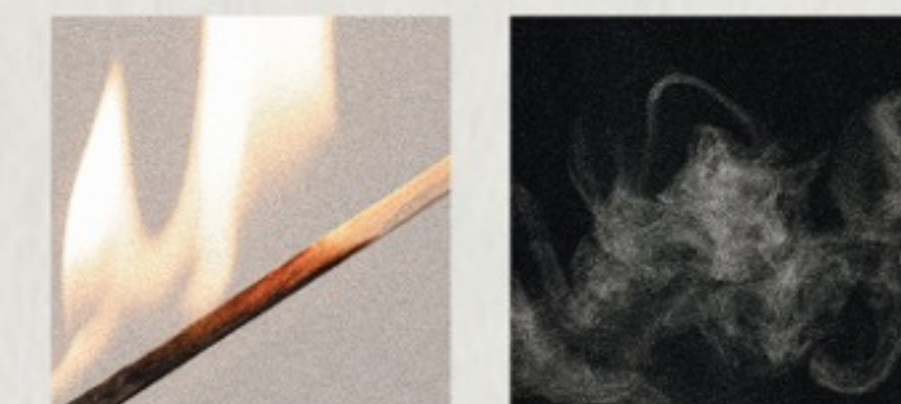




Substitution

And they compelled a passerby, Simon of Cyrene, who was coming in from the country, the father of Alexander and Rufus, to carry his cross.



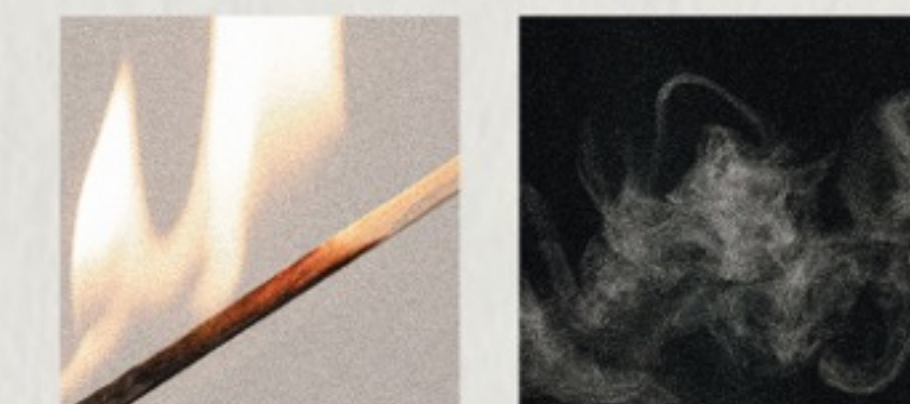
Substitution

Mark 15:7, 15, 27 ^{ESV}

⁷ And among the rebels in prison, who had committed murder in the insurrection, there was a man called Barabbas.

¹⁵ So Pilate, wishing to satisfy the crowd, released for them Barabbas, and having scourged Jesus, he delivered him to be crucified.

²⁷ And with him they crucified two robbers, one on his right and one on his left.



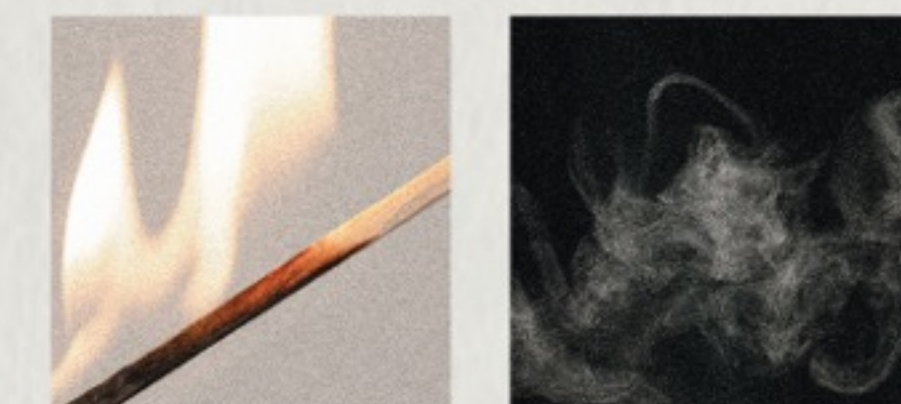
Deliverance

Mark 15:33 ^{ESV}

And when the sixth hour had come, there was darkness over the whole land until the ninth hour.

Exodus 10:21-22 ^{ESV}

Then the Lord said to Moses, “Stretch out your hand toward heaven, that there may be darkness over the land of Egypt, a darkness to be felt.” ²² So Moses stretched out his hand toward heaven, and there was pitch darkness in all the land of Egypt three days.

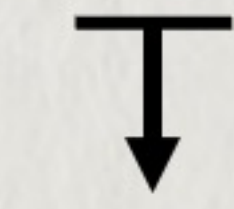

Access

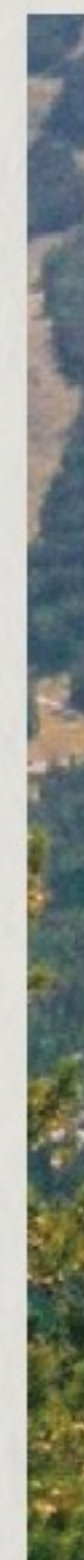
Mark 15:34, 37-38 ^{ESV}

³⁴ And at the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, “Eloi, Eloi, lema sabachthani?” which means, “My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?”

³⁷ And Jesus uttered a loud cry and breathed his last. ³⁸ **And the curtain of the temple was torn in two, from top to bottom.**



Access

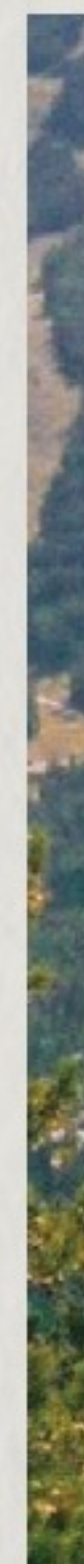


Romans 5:1-2 ^{ESV}

Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. ² **Through him we have also obtained access** by faith into this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in hope of the glory of God.



Access



Ephesians 2:12-13, 18-19 ESV

¹² Remember that you were at that time separated from Christ, alienated from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers to the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world. ¹³ **But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.**

¹⁸ **For through him we both have access in one Spirit to the Father.** ¹⁹ So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God.
