1 Corinthians 1:11-12 NIV

My brothers and sisters, some from Chloe's household have informed me that there are quarrels among you. ¹² What I mean is this: One of you says, "I follow Paul"; another, "I follow Apollos"; another, "I follow Cephas"; still another, "I follow Christ."

1 Corinthians 9:11-12 NIV


If we have sown spiritual seed among you, is it too much if we reap a material harvest from you? ¹² If others have this right of support from you, shouldn't we have it all the more?

Though I am free and belong to no one, I have made myself a slave to everyone, to win as many as possible. ²⁰ **To the Jews I became like a Jew**, to win the Jews. To those under the law I became like one under the law (though I myself am not under the law), so as to win those under the law. ²¹ To those not having the law I became like one not having the law (though I am not free from God's law but am under Christ's law), so as to win those not having the law. ²² **To the weak I became weak**, to win the weak. I have become all things to all people so that by all possible means I might save some.



1 Corinthians 9:25a, 26-27 NIV

Everyone who competes in the games goes into **strict training.** ²⁶ Therefore I do not run like someone running aimlessly; I do not fight like a boxer beating the air. ²⁷ No, I strike a blow to my body and make it my slave so that after I have preached to others, I myself will not be disqualified for the prize.
