





Sanctification:

1 Thessalonians 4:3 NIV


It is God's will that you should be sanctified: that you should **avoid** sexual immorality;

Genesis 2:24-25 NIV

That is why a man leaves his father and mother and is united to his wife, and they become one flesh. ²⁵ Adam and his wife were both naked, and they felt no shame.

Hebrews 13:4 NIV

Marriage should be honored by all, and the marriage bed kept pure, for God will judge the adulterer and all the sexually immoral.






